Hull: Steel  
Power: 2 x 6690hp Wartsillas

With accommodation for 28 guests and 21 crew, this Japanese-built yacht is currently for sale for a cool US\$70 million. Owned by the founder of Evergreen, the Taiwanese shipping giant, she has stopped in Shanghai and Hong Kong during her recent travels. She's on the market to make way for a new yacht – whether this will also have a hospital suite and cinema is still to be seen. *(2000 ranking: 1)*

Special features on this 146ft Royal Denship build for a Hong Kong client include a heated swimming pool on the aft main deck and a large wok pan with a special stove. Diana Yacht Design (*Evergreen, Alyssa M*) designed the yacht, which is set to launch in Denmark in December 2005. Denship has since signed contracts for two 'sisterships' for European clients.

The current Hong Kong client has put the former *Colombaio Sky* up for sale. The 118ft Dutch build has a steel hull, aluminium superstructure and teak decks. The yacht is reported to have almost reached 15 knots under sail, while under power she goes over 12 knots and cruises at 11.
