

## ATTESSA IV - 100 M (EX EVERGREEN)

Asian owners of large megayachts are very rare, but this yacht was originally commissioned for the owner of the Evergreen shipping company, and subsequently bore the name of said company. Built at a container ship yard, speed was obviously of great importance for the owner as she achieves 22.5-knots on her twin 6,600hp Wartsila diesels. At her cruising speed, the 100m - now owned by Dennis Washington an American businessman worth \$4.2-billion (ranked 201 on world's rich list) - has a range of 6,300 miles.
