P.B. BEHAGE 144FT PROJECT NOSTALGIC

A Dutch designer's take on a classic, long-range motor yacht

THE LATEST FROM DUTCH YACHT DESIGNER P.B. Behage is a classically inspired, long-range motor yacht designed for elegant cruising and far-flung travel. Lloyd's classed and MCA compliant, the 144ft Nostalgic's hull is intended to be constructed with grade A steel and a superstructure of Alustar and aluminum. Watertight bulkheads and watertight doors divide the hull into six compartments.

Accommodations for 10 are found in five staterooms—the master featuring a king-size bathtub, steam shower, walk-in ward-robe, study, and library would be situated on the main deck while the guest accommodations are on the lower deck.

While the exterior lines of Project Nostalgic are reminiscent of classic commuter vessels, she is designed with every modern amenity to ensure guest comfort. Additionally, extra attention has been placed on noise and vibration suppression with the use of floating floorboards and vibration dampers for ceilings and wall partitions and on all engines, pumps, and ducts.
