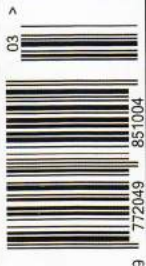

The 77 metre Legend was built in 1974 by IHC Verschure and last refitted in 2016. Her luxurious interior is designed by John Misiag Design and her exterior styling is by M.E. Consulting. Legend's interior can accommodate up to 26 guests in 13 rooms, including a master suite,

2 VIP staterooms, 4 double cabins, 4 twin cabins and 2 convertible cabins. She offers a wide range of entertainment including a gym, spa, pool, movie theatre and she also carries two 12m sport fishing boats. She is for sale through Fraser yachts.



Tansu's latest launch is 44 metre Cyclone. Exterior and Interior design and building is by Riza Tansu. Naval Architecture & Engineering is by Diana Yacht Design. She can accommodate up to eight guests and five crews. The upper deck is dedicated to the master cabin. There is also a comfortable lounge unit outside. The main deck interior features the wheelhouse, day-

head, the main salon with a wide library and dining area. The exterior deck layout has Tansu's signature beach area, aft facing lounge and dining. She is powered by two CAT C-32 1900 bhp E Rating engines. Top speed is 21.7 knots, while cruising is at 16 knots. Cyclone carries one 6.20m Rupert R6 "Tansu Edition" Tender and one 4.20m Zodiac Pro Tender.



Cyclone

38 metre Soprano was built by Hakvoort and has a steel hull and an aluminium superstructure. She has a classical overall feel, with an elegant canoe stern and can accommodate 10 guests in 4 cabins. Her interior design is by Felix Buytendijk and an exterior design by Diana Yacht Design. She is powered by Caterpillar engines of 600 hp each giving her a maximum speed of 13 knots and a cruising speed of 11 knots.
